A staff member will listen to your views on how best to address the situation and explain the next steps.

3 WE WILL ACT

We will work with those involved and contact their parents or guardians to help stop the behaviour.

Our Bí Cineálta policy explains how we prevent and address bullying behaviour. We review it every year — and student views matter.

WHAT IS BULLYING BEHAVIOUR?

Bullying is targeted behaviour, online or offline, that causes harm. It is repeated over time and involves an imbalance of power.

If you are unsure, speak to us anyway — you do not have to work it out alone.
